Midazolam, fentanyl, and alfentanil for endotracheal anesthesia in a patient with spinocerebellar ataxia type 1. Spinocerebellar ataxia type 1 (SCA1) is an autosomal dominant neurodegenerative disease. Dementia occurs in many patients with this disease and is associated with a significantly shortened life expectancy. We present a case of conscious sedation for endotracheal intubation in a patient with SCA1. Midazolam (0.03 mg/kg), fentanyl (2 µg/kg), and alfentanil (0.05 µg/kg) were used for sedation, and the induction of anesthesia was achieved with a bolus of propofol (1.5 mg/kg) and a rocuronium (0.9 mg/kg) infusion. Orotracheal intubation was easily performed without any complications. The patient had no subjective discomfort and had no abnormal signs in vital signs and laboratory data throughout the procedure. There was no sign of central nervous system depression. However, postoperative subjective discomfort occurred, and the dose of midazolam was increased to 1.2 mg/kg. The postoperative hospital stay was uneventful, and the patient was able to walk under the assistance of a nurse at discharge. There is no consensus regarding the optimum drug for conscious sedation in patients with SCA1. However, we suggest that a combination of propofol and rocuronium can be safely used for endotracheal intubation in patients with SCA 82157476af
